

How to collect dust samples to request an E.D.P.A.®

- 1) Do not make any cleaning in your home for 2-3 days.
- 2) After 2-3 days, beat the sheets on the floor and, if there is woodworm eaten furniture (e.g. chairs), beat it slightly to let the characteristic powder drop. Then collect the dust with broom and dustpan from all the surface of the floor of each room and put it into a plastic jar. No matter the amount of dust collected, but if it is very little, you can collect it even in some days. You have to collect everything you find: dust, fluff, hairs, papers, vegetable fragments, crumbs and so on. In the passage from one room to another, just slam the broom, there is no need to wash it or change it.

DO NOT USE THE VACUUM CLEANER.

- 3) Prepare a jar for each room, labeling with the name of the room (e.g. "bedroom", "living room", "kitchen" etc.). Choose light, large, plastic jars, such as those for urine/faeces collection usually sold in pharmacies.
- 4) Fill in the specific anamnestic form thoroughly, clearly writing the tax code which must be that of the person who makes the payment, to which the invoice will be issued and the email address to which you want to receive the parasitological report and the invoice.
- 5) If possible, send us some photos of your lesions to: **urania@edpa.it**They will allow us to have a complete picture of your dermatological problem for a confirmation of our diagnosis.
- 6) Make the payment of Euro 125.00 (VAT included), by one of the following modes :

- 7) Put the jars into a padded envelope or into a Postal Box together with the anamnestic form and the copy of your payment slip.
