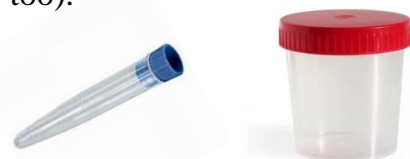




METHOD OF PRESERVATION OF SPECIMENS FOR THE IDENTIFICATION SERVICE

- 1) Specimens of insects and their larvae, as well as any colony of mites, should be stored in **white alcohol** (it may be fine, however, **denatured alcohol** too).
In this way they are maintained for long periods of time.
Adult insects generally keep themselves well **dry**.
Close the tube or jar well.



- 2) Fill in the sample accompanying form, clearly writing the VAT Reg No - which must be that of the person who makes the payment, to which the invoice will be issued-and the email address to which to direct the report and the invoice.

- 3) Make the payment of Euro 125.00 (VAT included), in one of the following modes:

- 4) Place the specimens in a padded envelope or in a postal box together with the accompanying form and the copy of the payment slip.

- 5) Ship, preferably with "POSTA 1" (Italian Postal Service) or courier, to:

- 6) The parasitological report and the invoice will be sent by email within 24/48 hours from the receipt of the specimens of arthropods.
